CLUB RULES FOR PLAYERS AND STAFF

- Players & Staff must make themselves available for all matches and training sessions and ensure that attendance is punctual unless prior permission is granted for absence by the manager or appointed person.
- Players who are injured or suspended must attend matches unless prior permission is granted for absence by the manager or appointed person.
- Players who do not attend matches or training will have their wages deducted pro rata in accordance with agreed rate.
- All players must travel to the away matches on the Team Bus unless a valid reason is provided prior to travel.
- Players and Staff must at all times wear the Club Tracksuit & Polo Shirt or the Suit & Tie provided when representing the club at 1st team matches or any specific function as requested by the Club.
- Players and Staff must at all times remember they are representatives of Fraserburgh FC both on match days and while away from the club. You must behave in a manner that will not harm nor be deemed likely to cause harm to the image of the Club. In the event of a breach of this rule the Club may apply disciplinary action up to and including dismissal.
- Management in the first instance, and ultimately the Board of Directors, will be the arbiters in whether or not a breach of club rules has occurred.
- Players and Staff must notify the Club Secretary of a change of address or telephone number and also any personal particulars such as changes to bank details.
- Players and Staff must at all times adhere to the SFA Articles of Association. A copy of these will be provided by the Club Secretary at the start of each season in either electronic or in hard copy format.
- The club may require any player or member of staff to submit to random testing and searching for illegal substances. Testing will in all cases be undertaken by a suitably qualified professional. In the event of a positive result or refusal to undertake medical tests and/or search, the Club will apply disciplinary action up to and including dismissal.
- Any player or member of staff charged with a criminal offence will be subject to possible suspension pending the outcome of any criminal proceedings. If a case is proven dismissal may result.
