DISABILITY POLICY

Fraserburgh Football Club (The Club) recognises its responsibilities and commitment to ensuring that disabled supporters and customers have as full access as is reasonably possible to all goods, services and facilities provided or offered to the public by the Club.

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that Fraserburgh Football Club complies with the Equality Act 2010 and to ensure that disabled people falling within the definition of the Act are treated equally and fairly.

The Club recognises it must take into account the needs of Visiting Disabled Supporters as well as its' own and will liaise with the opposing Clubs highlighting the facilities that are available and making the tickets directly available to the Visiting Clubs as may operate their own Disabled Supporters Clubs.

In all areas where Disabled Supporters are present the Club will provide a responsible person to assist these Supporters where they have no carer, to ensure that they can access the Ground and its' facilities without difficulty.

The Club will treat any complaint against its employees as a serious matter and that if found to be in breach of the Act the employee would be dealt with under the Club's Disciplinary Procedures.

The Club's commitment is, therefore, to confront and eliminate discrimination whether by reason of sex, sexual orientation, race, nationality, ethnic origin, colour, religion or disability.

In respect of disabled facilities at Bellslea Park, The Club offers accommodation for all disabled groups.

Guidelines for an Accessible Ground.

1 Approaches/Entrances

A designated entrance is situated at the south end of the main stand where ample room is available for the entry of a wheelchair.

2 Parking

A designated disabled car park is located adjacent to the ground.

3 Disabled Viewing Areas

A suitable area is available at the south end of the stand.

4 Assistance Dogs

It is the Clubs Policy that guide dogs will be permitted within the Ground.

5 Steps & Stairs

All steps and stairs are to be kept clean and in good order.

6 Catering/Refreshments

The Kiosks is located in a different area of the Ground the Hospitality Lounge is situated in the disabled area and refreshments are available free of charge.

7 Toilets

Fully equipped toilets are provided in the Disabled area.

8 Means of Escape

The Disabled section has an easy escape route in the event of an evacuation and dedicated responsible person will be on hand to accompany disabled supporters out of the Ground
